Through these initiatives, THISO Myanmar continues to stand beside our community, offering dignity and compassion to those who need it most.

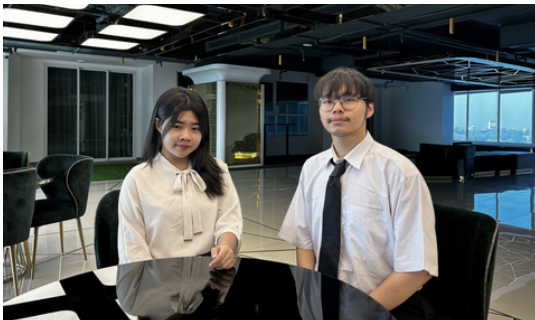
CORPORATE UPDATES



Teams in Action: Advancing Safety with Seismic Technology

On January 21, 2026, our Technical Operation department conducted a vital orientation for the new seismic detector system to enhance the safety of all tenants and stakeholders. These advanced devices provide the earliest possible earthquake warnings through audible alarms at the Fire Control Center (FCC) and high-visibility strobe-light signaling at the Tower-1 reception and Tower-2 14th-floor reception areas.

In the event of an emergency, the system is designed to automatically trigger sirens, strobe lights, and stairwell ventilation fans while simultaneously unlocking emergency doors to ensure a rapid and safe evacuation.
